- 1. Midterm Examination for classes 6-12 begin on 21.09.2020.
- 2. Regular classes will not be held during the examination days.
- 3. All the students should prepare well for the exam and be ready ten minutes before the exam.

- 5. Check the internet connection and have a standby device ready.
- 6. The Duration of the exam is two hours and half an hour will be given for uploading/technical glitches.
- 7. Students are requested to contact the concerned teachers if they are taking more than 20 minutes to upload.
- 8. Each paper will have two parts. Paper I Objective Microsoft Form and paper II Subjective pen and paper test.
- 9. After clicking on the assignment, open the Microsoft form, attempt it and submit it.
- 10. After that, attempt the Subjective paper in your test notebook.
- 11. Students should write their name, roll no., class and section neatly on the right-hand corner of the answer script.
- 12. Scan the sheets in proper order and submit a single PDF file.
- 13. Both the objective and subjective papers must be completed before the assigned time.
